



## You can help protect your family and property from storms

### Things you can do DURING a storm

During a storm, there are simple things you can do to help protect your family and property:

- Never enter or travel through floodwater
- Stay indoors and clear of windows
- If driving, put your hazard lights on and pull over to the side of the road keeping clear of drains, causeways, streams, creeks, trees and powerlines
- If outdoors, seek secure cover away from drains, causeways, gutters, streams, creeks, trees and powerlines
- Listen to your local radio station and other media for information, updates and advice
- For emergency help in floods and storms, call the NSW SES on 132 500. If your situation is life threatening call 000 (triple zero)
